

## REACHING NEIGHBORS & NATIONS

Dave and Susan Broadwell – Jesus Film Project (Orlando)

In Costa Rica (where a Jesus Film Mission Trip took place earlier in April), Jesus Film Project partnered with a ministry to children, showing the Story of Jesus for Children in many classrooms on a daily basis. During the trip, the film was shown to over 80 classes full of kids. In addition to the showings, the team worked with teachers at these same locations, teaching them how to use a curriculum called, "Vital Values with Jesus." This enables the teachers to help the children grow in their understanding of the Lord and also living out their faith. It is such a joy for JFP teams to be able to do this in public schools there.

Dave was recently asked to move from his role as a missions trip manager to be the director of Jesus Film Mission Trips. This transition wasn't expected, but he humbly accepted the role. Basically, he will be doing many similar things, but his role will now encompass providing leadership to the whole department and helping set strategic direction for the missions arm of the Jesus Film Project. He has much to learn to lead the department of 30-35 people as they reach out all over the globe. Pray for wisdom in this transition and a close walk with the Lord.

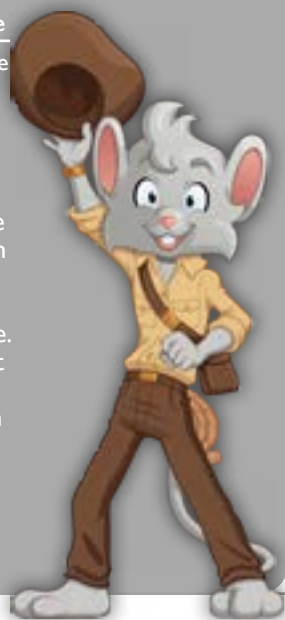
